Introduction

The statistical tabulations in this volume are based on a *Berkeley IGS Poll* completed by the Institute of Governmental Studies (IGS) at the University of California, Berkeley. The poll was administered online in English and Spanish January 15-21, 2020 among 6,845 registered voters statewide, of whom 5,170 were considered likely voters in the November 2020 general election. In order to cover a broad range of issues and still minimize voter fatigue the overall sample was divided into two random subsamples of 3,364 and 3,381 registered voters on some questions.

The survey was administered by distributing email invitations to stratified random samples of the state's registered voters. Once the questionnaire and email invitations had been finalized, they were translated into the Spanish and reviewed for cultural appropriateness. Each email invited voters to participate in a non-partisan survey conducted by IGS and provided a link to the IGS website where the survey was housed. Reminder emails were distributed to non-responding voters and an opt out link was provided for voters not wishing to participate and not wanting to receive future emails from IGS about the survey.

Samples of registered voters with email addresses were provided to IGS by Political Data, Inc., a leading supplier of registered voter lists in California. The email addresses of voters were derived from information contained on the state's official voter registration rolls. The overall sample of registered voters with email addresses was stratified in an attempt to obtain a proper balance of survey respondents across major segments of the registered voter population.

To protect the anonymity of survey respondents, voters' email addresses and all other personally identifiable information were purged from the data file and replaced with a unique and anonymous identification number during data processing. At the conclusion of the data processing phase, post-stratification weights were applied to align the sample to population characteristics of the state's overall registered voter population. Likely voters were identified based on a voter's stated interest and intention to vote in the presidential primary election and factoring in their history of voting in past elections.

The sampling error associated with the results from the survey are difficult to calculate precisely due to the effects of sample stratification and the post-stratification weighting. Nevertheless, it is likely that the results from the overall sample of registered voters and from the sample of likely voters in the November 2020 general election are subject to an approximate sampling error of approximately +/- 2 percentage points at the 95% confidence level, while findings from each of the random subsamples are subject to an approximate sampling error of +/- 2.5 percentage points.

(ASKED OF A RANDOM SUBSAMPLE OF 3,381 REGISTERED VOTERS STATEWIDE) Do you approve or disapprove of the way Donald Trump is handling foreign policy?

(ASKED OF LIKELY VOTERS IN THE NOVEMBER 2020 GENERAL ELECTION) If Donald Trump is the Republican candidate for president and the November general election for president were being held today, how likely would you be to vote to re-elect him?
