is Chair of the geography department at Salve Regina College in Newport, R.I. He has published works on Native American landscapes and on popular highway culture. He is noted for his poetry of the Massachusetts Turnpike and his work on the suburban imagery of Los Angeles.

is an artist whose recent works include The Minnesota History Center Courtyard, the Penn Central Restoration in New York and the Philadelphia River Walk Project. He seeks to create art that is temporally, spatially and socially responsive to its particular environment.

### **R. Burton Litton, Jr.**

is a Professor Emeritus in landscape architecture at the University of California, Berkeley, and a pioneer in visual assessment of natural landscapes. His *Forest Landscape Description and Inventories* and *Water and Landscape: An Aesthetic Overview of the Role of Water in the Landscape* (with Robert Tetlow, Jens Sorensen and Russell Beatty) set methods and standards currently used by the national parks.

### **David Lowenthal**

is Emeritus Professor of geography at University College, London. His recent books are *The Past Is a Foreign Country*, *Landscape Meanings and Value* and *The Politics of the Past*.

### **Dean MacCannell**

is a Professor of Community Development and Sociology at University of California, Davis, and co-executive editor of *The American Journal of Semiotics*. His research on social policy reflects on small communities, the mythology of modern culture and technology and the unconscious.

### **Joe R. McBride**

is a Professor in the Departments of Landscape Architecture and Forestry and Resource Management at the University of

California, Berkeley. He teaches courses on ecology and his research is focused on the influence of humans on forest succession.

**Thomas R. Oslund**
