
Performance directions:

These boxed notes should be played with a sense of freedom, therefore are marked *con rubato*.




In the final movement of the work, *Visions Appear*, tremolo is used. These will be marked as either 'measured' or *con rubato*.

Programme note:

Lovers and Madmen is a three movement work, based upon Shakespeare's *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. Harmonically, this piece explores the ideas of Peter Schat's "Tone Clock". Each movement depicts a particular scene, inspired by the play. Movement 1, *Dawn Breaks* uses soft dynamics and subtly shifting harmonies to introduce the listener to Oberon's Kingdom. Movement 2, *The Forest Awakens* features gestures which emerge from a busy turbulent texture giving the impression of magic stirring within the forest. The final movement *Visions Appear*, creates an uncertain atmosphere through chromatic harmony and playful imitation. As humans become intertwined with love and the supernatural, the piece builds to a dramatic conclusion... were these visions reality or just a dream?
