In the Study limitations and recommendations subsection of the Discussion, there is an error in the fifth sentence of the first paragraph. The correct sentence is: Another possible limitation was that the study's samples of Asian Americans and Latino/a/x Americans may not have been the best representatives for examining cultural variation, as most participants were born in the United States and all came from an American university.
