## POLICY

The *Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology* publishes original manuscripts on the ethnography, ethnohistory, languages, arts, archaeology, and prehistory of the native peoples of Alta and Baja California and the Great Basin.

Provide an *original and five copies* of all written material submitted for consideration. Manuscripts must be typewritten and double-spaced throughout. The original must be letter quality with margins of at least one inch throughout to permit machine reading onto disk. If at all possible, submit, or be prepared to submit, a 3½-in. disk containing the manuscript file. Specify the machine on which the disk was prepared, the disk-operating system used, and the word processing program.

In preparing manuscripts for submission, consult the style guide published in Vol. 14, No. 1, and follow instructions therein.

Keep manuscripts as brief as possible and include abstracts for articles and reports: articles (to 30 pages), reports (under 10 pages), comments (under 5 pages), and reviews (2-3 pages). Suggested page counts should include all illustrative material. Manuscripts submitted for consideration should conform strictly to the format of this issue. Tables usually can be set to type, and must be submitted single-spaced on one or more pages. Drawings and photographs should be of high quality. If possible, reduce drawings to conform to the single- or double-column format of the *Journal*, allowing ample room for captions. Submit captions on a separate page. References should be double-spaced and should conform to the style of this issue. End notes are permitted, but should be kept as brief as possible. All articles and reports will be reviewed by the editorial staff and no fewer than two anonymous referees. Authors may request tear sheets and may reproduce, at their expense, up to 100 copies of each contribution published in the *Journal*. Reprints may be given away or used as class handouts, but may not be sold.

## SUBSCRIPTIONS

The *Journal* is published twice yearly. Subscriptions are available on an annual basis only, and the rate is \$25.00, payable in U.S. currency. Specify the volume for which the subscription is ordered and the mailing address. Include check or money order and mail to:
