
Jerry Dyer believes in the importance of second chances. But his leadership of the department begs the question: how many chances should a public official get?

Abstract:

Fresno's deputy chief of police is in prison. Wiretap recording played for the jury exposed a web of corruption, some of which appeared to involve other members of the police department. The chief of police, Jerry Dyer, swore under oath that he never had reason to distrust his second-incommand. This multimedia project looks at Dyer's history in the department, going back to his first days as chief when he was already embroiled in a sexual misconduct scandal, and seeks to answer the question: how could Dyer not have known what his top deputy was up to?

Jerry Dyer was named police chief by then-city-manager Dan Hobbs on July 18, 2001. Less than a week later, he was already embroiled in a scandal

In an article published on July 22, 2001, Fresno Bee reporter Doug Hoagland outlined charges that had haunted Dyer since the mid-1980's. The article was headlined "Cops twice probed allegations Dyer had affair with girl. 16."

The allegations stemmed from a relationship Dyer reportedly had as a young officer with a 16-year-old girl in 1985, when Dyer was 26. If true, this would potentially have been a felony, but the statute of limitations had run out by the time the article was published. The incident was investigated once shortly after it was alleged to have occurred, and again in response to a citizen complaint after Dyer became spokesman for the department in 1995.

The article was based on interviews with unnamed police sources who were privy to the investigation, as well as family members of the alleged victim, although the alleged victim herself would not confirm or deny the allegations to the *Bee* . Contacted for this article, she declined to comment.

Dyer refused to deny the allegations to the *Bee*, which quoted him saying "I'm not going to sit here before you and confirm those things or deny those things ... All I can tell you is that the relationships that I have had outside of my marriage, when I was a young man, have been dealt with... God's forgiven me. My wife's forgiven me. This department's forgiven me and looked into a lot of things in my past." When asked by Hoagland why he wouldn't simply deny the


