The International Committee will have the opportunity to contribute to international medicine projects and resource development that are helpful and beneficial to students and residents.

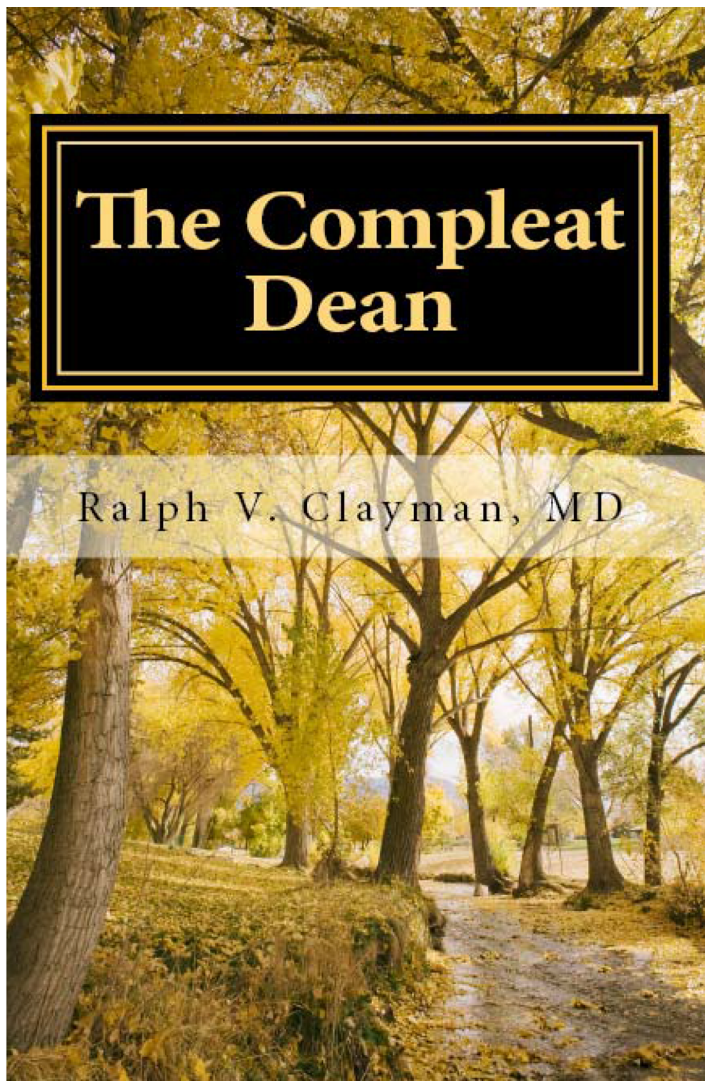
Membership Committee

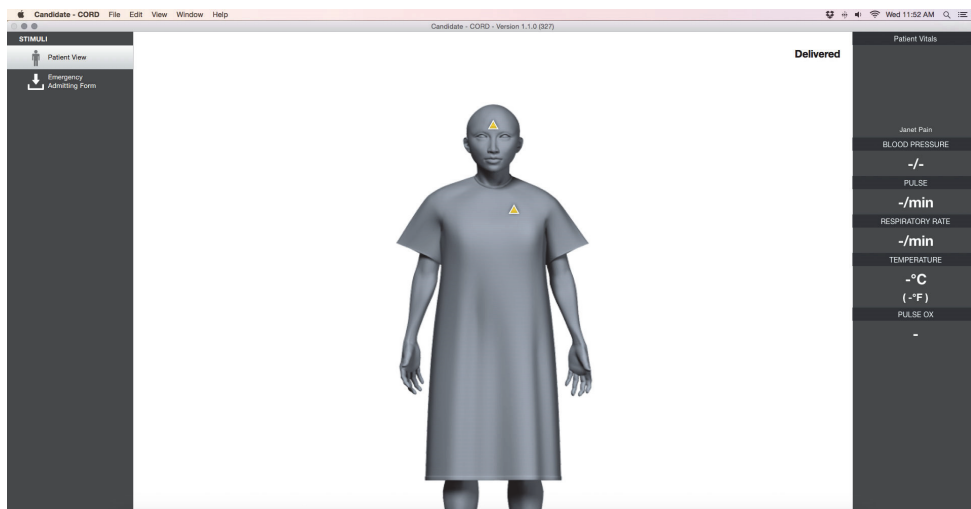
