


Figure 3: Expected Change in English Use Among Latino and Asian Respondents, 2005-2006.

Mean change in expected value and 95% confidence intervals were calculated by simulating the first difference in the predictors with the use of 1000 randomly drawn values from a sampling distribution with a mean equal to the maximum likelihood estimates and variance equal to the

variance-covariance matrix of these estimates. Column A represents the analyses for the first generation and column B for the later generation immigrants. Dark circles are the effects for Latinos and hollow circles indicate the effects for Asians. Model summaries are as follows: 1st Generation Latino Adjusted R2=.68, N=265; 1st Generation Asians Adjusted R2=.57, N=250; Later generation Latinos Adjusted R2=.40, N=268. Later generation Asians Adjusted R2=.15, N=250.
