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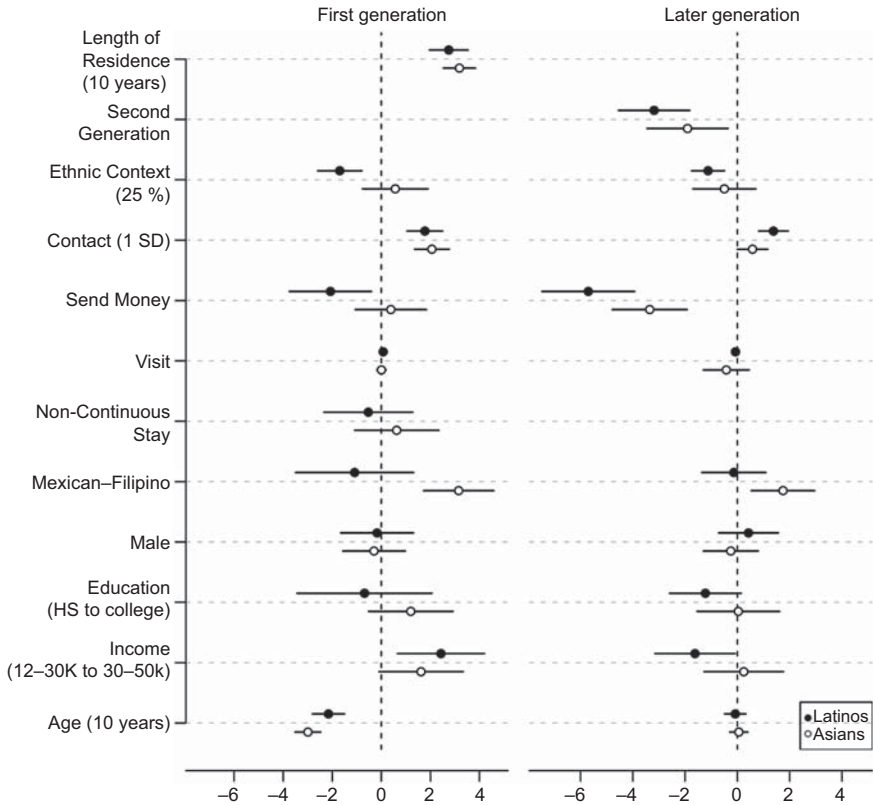
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## Erratum

**Figure 3:** Expected Change in English Use Among Latino and Asian Respondents, 2005–2006.

The dependent variable was the English use of the respondent, 0=Non-English Speaking, 30=Only English speaking. Mean change in expected value and 95% confidence intervals were calculated by simulating the first difference in the predictors with the use of 1000 randomly drawn values from a sampling distribution with a mean equal to the maximum likelihood estimates and variance equal to the

variance-covariance matrix of these estimates. Column A represents the analyses for the first generation and column B for the later generation immigrants. Dark circles are the effects for Latinos and hollow circles indicate the effects for Asians. Model summaries are as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Generation Latino Adjusted  $R^2=.68$ ,  $N=265$ ; 1<sup>st</sup> Generation Asians Adjusted  $R^2=.57$ ,  $N=250$ ; Later generation Latinos Adjusted  $R^2=.40$ ,  $N=268$ . Later generation Asians Adjusted  $R^2=.15$ ,  $N=250$ .
