What is Omeka?

- Free, open source web-publishing platform, developed at the Rosenzweig Center for History and New Media at George Mason University
- Displays images, documents, audio, video

Why Omeka?

- Create online exhibits
- Easily manage digital objects and metadata
- Invite user contributions, student curators
- Tell the story behind our collections
- Draw connections, bring context

Curator Dashboard

- Enhance curatorial workflows
- Allow easier import of objects into Omeka sites from web 2.0 sites
- Facilitate easier metadata creation and editing

Media Display

- Set up profiles and viewers for different item types, collections, or file extensions
- Example item types: pdfs, moving images, audio, oral histories, JPEG2000 images, maps
- Example viewers: OHMS (Oral History Media Synchronizer, Internet Archive Book Reader, MediaElement.js, PanZoom Image Zooming, OpenSeaDragon

Setup Manage Display Profiles Manage Profile Assignments

This plugin allows you to display content using any of the installed viewers. Each viewer requires configuration options to tell it where to find the media files to display, and how exactly to display them. You can save these options using *Display Profiles*. Each display profile contains all options necessary for one of the installed viewers to display media for an item.

After you create a display profile, you need to assign it to the items you want to display using that profile. Each *Profile Assignment* assigns a set of items (by item type, collection, or type of attached file) to a display profile.

If you want to get this up and running quickly, you can use this page to set all this up automatically. For each viewer, this form will create a new item type with fields for any metadata the viewer might require. A default display profile is also created for this viewer, and a profile assignment is created to link the default profile to the default item type.

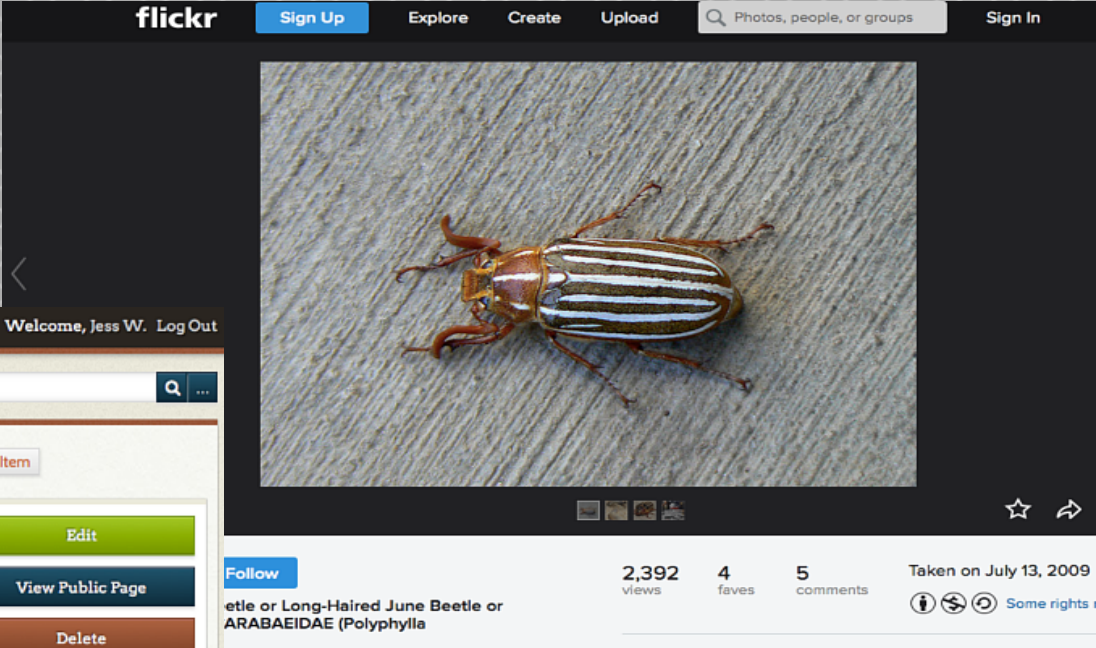
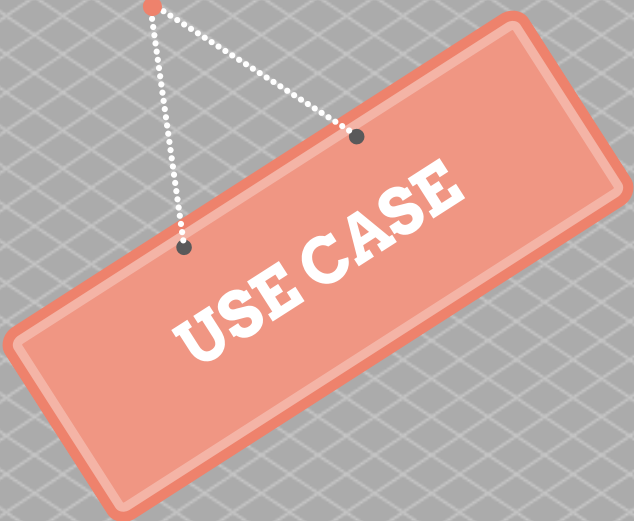

Flickr Import

- Import images and metadata from Flickr into Omeka
- By URL: single image, entire album, or selected images from an album
- Metadata is cross-walked from Flickr to Dublin Core in Omeka
- Tags also imported

Item History Log

- Displays a history of curatorial actions directly on the Item Record (administrative view)
- Create reports by collection, user, date, etc. listing changes made to items (eg. creation of items, changes to item files, metadata modifications)

CONTENTdm

- Import CONTENTdm items and their metadata into Omeka
- Metadata mapping based on assigned DC element in CONTENTdm
- Can opt to synchronize CONTENTdm items with their corresponding Omeka items

Bulk Metadata Editor

- Make metadata changes across multiple items at once
- Select items for changing based on collection, content of metadata fields, etc.
- Edit existing metadata or add/create new metadata

METS & MerrittLink

METS plugin

- Export individual Omeka objects or entire Omeka collections as METS objects
- Interoperable option, many repositories accept METS

MerrittLink

- Exports METS xml file and item files from Omeka into the UC3 Merritt archival repository
