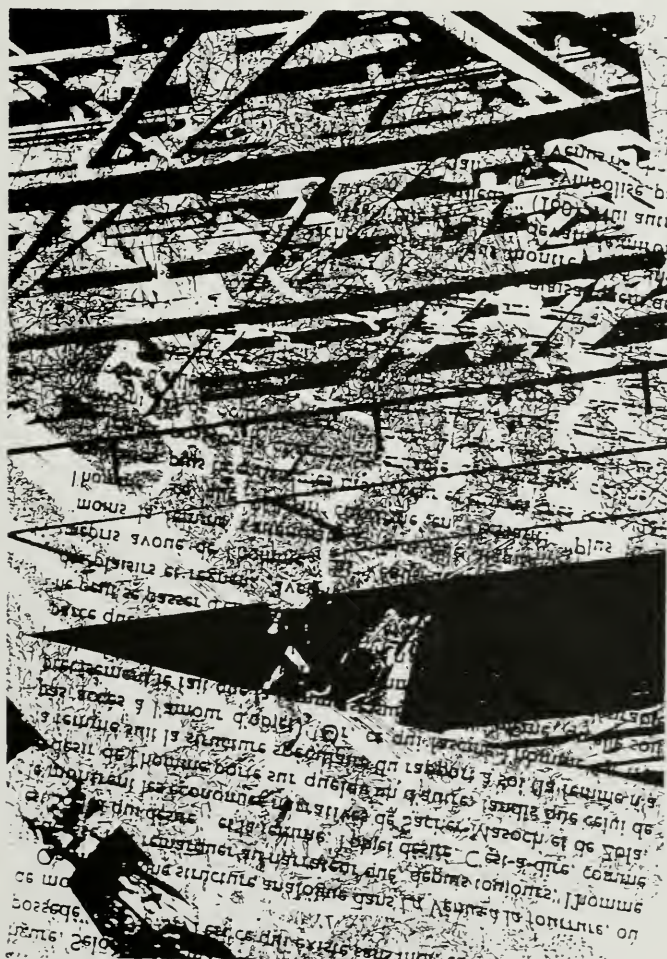
Note from the Editor
