First Interdisciplinary Symposium *Biogeography of the Carpathians: Evolution of Biodiversity in a Spatiotemporal Context*, 26–28 September 2013, Kraków, Poland

The Carpathians represent one of the European biodiversity centres, a Quaternary refugium with high importance for postglacial history of the biota and a harbour of rare and relic lineages. As a complex and well defined system of mountainous and alpine habitats they also provide an excellent model for biogeographical studies.

The aim of the meeting is to provide a multifaceted overview of recent advances concerning the evolution of the Carpathian biota in the spati-

otemporal context, and the impact of this area on the European (and wider) scale. It is addressed to scientists representing various research fields, to stimulate discussions based on diverse methodological approaches (e.g. phylogeographical inference, geographical range analyses, palaeobiological reconstructions, ecological modeling) and biological groups (plants, animals, fungi).
